The Lorain County Fair wine exhibit started in 1992 and has grown to be one of the largest, if not the largest, county fair displays in the state. We expect it to grow larger this year.

For this year, there will be an expanded wine display courtesy of the Dead Yeast Society. Along with the wine competition, there will be displays on wine making, wine making equipment, and Dead Yeast Society members will be available to answer all your questions.

The Dead Yeast Society is an active group of amateur wine makers from the area. They meet monthly to discuss all aspects of wine making – from recipes, supplies, techniques, growing ingredients, and much more. The group evaluates each other's wines and samples of foods made with wine.

Everyone is welcome to attend their meetings and join the Society. Meetings are held the first Wednesday of each month at Matus Winery at 6:30 pm.
